$$\begin{array}{r} 1870 \\ 1871 \\ \hline 3741 \end{array} \quad \begin{array}{l} 3+7=10 \\ = 4+1=5 \end{array} \quad \begin{array}{l} \text{Friedenschluß.} \\ = 10,5,1871. \end{array}$$

$$\begin{array}{r} 1914 \\ 1915 \\ \hline 3829 \end{array} \quad \begin{array}{l} 3+8=11 \\ = 2+9=11 \end{array} \quad \begin{array}{l} \text{Friedenschluß.} \\ = 11,11,1915. \end{array}$$
